The Rapid City Rifle Club will conduct a youth programs as we have for thirty-three (33) years. The programs are conducted at **Hunter Education and Archery Park** on Game-Fish and Parks Outdoor Campus – West, 4140 Knutson St, Rapid City, SD 57702.

The program instructs youth in basic pistol and rifle marksmanship with focus on recreational shooting and competition. Initially, we cover basic marksmanship, position shooting, range operations and safety.

The Rifle program will be conducted on **Tuesday and Thursday evenings begin on December 17th** and run into April of the following year. **We start at 6:30 PM and are normally done by 8:00.** Participants may attend the rifle program either Tuesday or Thursday evening.

The NRA Basic Shooting Courses are provided for kids new to the programs. Their age, physical strength, and concentration ability may dictate the program participation. Progression into the advanced programs will be allowed based on individual ability, attendance and attitude. Most shooters may in rifle no younger than 8 years old.

The program sign up opportunities will continue through January 2020. If you have a child who may be interested, look up Rapid city Rifle Club on Facebook or stop in at the Hunter Education Park on Tuesday or Thursday evening. You can always call one of us listed below and we'll answer questions!

We ask a parent to join the Rapid City Rifle Club's and the annual membership is \$35; their children participate in the programs free. Additionally, we ask parents to be involved and support the child by assisting with setup and clean-up each evening.
